Energy deregulation as a driving force

The amendment to the Energy Industry and Organization Act 2000 (Gas Industry Act) introduced the balance group model in Austria. Thus, in the deregulated market it is possible for every market participant to settle the differences between the contracted and measured data to the originator.

Neutral, independent data processing

AGCS ensures data confidentiality and the orderly and neutral settlement of balancing energy on the gas market in Austria. The energy volumes required for balancing are made available or obtained by the participants of the balancing energy market at daily auctions. The prices are formed by competition of the participants' active there.

Functions and tasks

AGCS Gas Clearing and Settlement AG is responsible for the determination, price formation and settlement of balancing energy in Austria. Based on planned and actual feed or withdrawal into/from the grid, AGCS determines the balancing energy for each market participant of the Austrian gas market.
